NEWS UPDATE

Election of new Committee Members:

Following the AGM on 11 December 2013, we are delighted to welcome to the BACFI committee: Cariss Hamilton, Ian Brookes-Howells, Julian Abenbrook, Sally Bevan, and Hannah Laming. Furthermore, many congratulations to BACFI committee members: Lorinda Long and James Kitching for their election to Bar Council in November, and to member Kevin McGinty who has taken over as Chair of the Employed Barristers' Committee on the Bar Council and will be conducting a review into the EBC's terms of reference, constitution and composition.

New Handbook for the Bar:

As of 6 January 2014, the new Handbook for the Bar has now come into force.

There will be an opportunity for members to debate and explore the impact of the new handbook at our Professional Issues seminar, which is to be held later on in the Spring.

2013 CPD Record Cards:

This year's CPD record cards will NOT have to be sent in to the BSB by 31 January 2014. The BSB has decided to move to a "spot-check" regime; however, you must still keep a personal record of the 12 hours you undertook last year and next year, and retain each record for a period of 12 months.

QASA:

Judgment was handed down on 20 January 2014, in the Judicial Review brought by the Criminal Barristers Association, on the legality of Quality Assurance Scheme for Advocated. The judgment citation is [2013] EWHC 28 (Admin).

Their Lordships found in favour of the LSB, and the QASA scheme will now continue in its roll out and implementation.

Consultation on Court Fees:

The Ministry of Justice issued a consultation on court fees in early December 2013, which closes on 21 January 2014. As one of the proposals, a 5% charge for the value of the claim was suggested for cases, with a payable fee cap of £10,000.

This "enhanced fee" has been vigorously opposed by the Bar Council, whose response will be published on the Bar Council website in due course.

Judicial Appointments:

He also provided (surely a first for a Court of Appeal Judge!) an extremely impressive array of accompanying slides of great works of art to assist in illustrating his points. The annual Christmas party followed in the crypt.
