# **Estates**

### **Vehicle Access/Exit**

As the redevelopment of One Gray's Inn (formerly 19/21 High Holborn) continues the necessary traffic arrangements must remain in place. There is no vehicle access from High Holborn, nor into the Paddock from Gray's Inn Road (except for construction vehicles). Vehicular access and egress for Gray's Inn Square and South Square will continue to be from Gray's Inn Road through the gate adjacent to the pedestrian crossing. Please note that traffic around Gray's Inn Square moves anti-clockwise.

# **Car Parking**

Although the access arrangements are different, car parking facilities are still available throughout the estate. Daily car parking is available at a cost of £20 per day and there is no need to pre-book. A half day rate of £10 is available when parking after 1pm; there are no concessions. ### **Pedestrian Access**

Please note that for reasons of safety due to the movement of two-way traffic through the Gray's Inn Road entrance/exit there is no pedestrian use of this entrance/exit. Similarly, no pedestrian access via the Paddock is possible as it is being used by construction vehicles. This arrangement will remain in place until the vehicle access from High Holborn will re-open planned for October 2019.

In respect of the pedestrian access to the Inn by the One Gray's Inn construction site, this has now re-opened during restricted hours and access is available from 6pm weekdays through until 7am the following morning and all through the weekend after 1pm on Saturdays.

# **Electric Vehicle Charging Posts**

There are a number of electric vehicle charging posts at locations throughout the Inn. Take up of this facility has been good. Spaces are available only to annual permit holders and a small number remain available. ## Library

Work continues on the <u>Lauterpacht Collection of International Law</u>, with updates posted on the Inn's <u>Twitter</u> and Facebook accounts. Remote log-ins for <u>Bloomsbury Professional Online</u> are still available to members of Gray's Inn. The service provides full-text access to materials in 20 practice areas including, company and commercial, employment, environment, family, local government, property and personal injury. Currently displayed on the New Books wall (opposite the photocopiers) are titles including <u>Preferential Trade</u> <u>Agreements and International Law</u>, a guide to <u>The Criminal Finances Act 2017</u> and <u>Interpreting the NPPF: the New National Planning Policy</u>. You can browse recent acquisitions at any time by visiting the <u>Library Catalogue</u> online and clicking on <u>New Books</u>.

Members can sign up to receive the <u>Library Bulletin</u>, to keep up to date with current opening hours, services and events. Rolling Library news and information is also published via the Inn's <u>Twitter</u> and <u>Facebook</u> accounts.

Are you due in court and in need of a law report or pages from a textbook? Over 80% of requests fulfilled by the Library's <u>Document Supply Service</u> are for use in judicial proceedings. The service is available to any members unable to visit the Library in person, particularly those outside London. Full details can be found on our webpages.

#### **Archives**

Preparations are in hand for the move of the Archives to 9 Gray's Inn Square in the Autumn and the appointment of an Archive Assistant as soon as possible. An exhibition at the rear of the Chapel about Bertha Cave is planned for the Michaelmas term to mark the centenary of the Sex Disqualification (Removal) Act 1919.

## Chapel

This term finishes with two major events. On Thursday April 4<sup>th</sup> we have our annual "Words and Music" evening, focusing this year on the Prayer Book Canticles, with choral settings from the Chapel Choir and solos from five Musicals, interspersed with some poetry from TS Eliot and others. Entry is free and open to all. There's a Supper to follow but you may be too late to apply for tickets!

On Sunday April 7<sup>th</sup> the Inn welcomes the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, to deliver the Mulligan Sermon during Choral Mattins at 11.15am. After Easter there are further Mattins on May 12<sup>th</sup>, June 16<sup>th</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a festive Mattins on July 21<sup>st</sup> followed by a Picnic Lunch in the Walks. Lunch tickets can be booked online. On Sunday May 19<sup>th</sup> at 11.15am, there will be a Sung Eucharist for Eastertide.

The next Evensong will be on Thursday May 16<sup>th</sup>, it begins at 6pm and finishes by 6.45pm and hence there will be time for those attending the Guest night to come to this service. It is hoped that those who attend their own parish church on Sundays will see Evensong as a way of supporting the Inn's Chapel.

The Inn continues to have a monthly Holy Communion – a simple half hour service from the Book of Common Prayer. This will take place in Chapel at 6.00pm on May  $7^{th}$ , June  $4^{th}$ , and July  $1^{st}$ .

The season of Summer Concerts begins on June 11<sup>th</sup> and on the following three Tuesdays. A brochure will soon be available. You can book for the Supper which follows, and there's a reduced charge for attending all four. Entry to the Chapel is, as always, free.

Services in Chapel are open to everyone, members, students and the general public. Please contact Michelle Clark if you want to stay for lunch on Sundays or the Supper after the Summer Concerts. The Chapel is also open every weekday when Hall is open for people to use for prayer and quiet reflection.
