Scholarships Trust

Car Parking

Car parking spaces are available in various locations throughout the estate accessed from High Holborn, Gray's Inn Road and Theobald's Road. Annual Permits cost £2,760 and can be purchased at a pro-rata rate for the remainder of the year. Electric Car Charging Points

Planning and Listed Building Consent is currently being sought for a number of electric vehicle charging points to be situated at various sites throughout the Inn. The first points will be installed in South Square and then elsewhere depending on demand. Spaces, to be allocated for a single user, will include electricity and be offered at a discounted rate from the annual car parking charge representing excellent value for money. <u>Works</u>

Various maintenance and refurbishment work has been carried out by the Inn and some tenants over the past months. Thank you for the patience and understanding of those who have been affected. This work is now drawing to an end. New projects will be starting in the summer including the redecoration of the inward facing windows of Gray's Inn Square and the rebuilding of part of the Jockey's Field boundary wall close to the Theobald's Road entrance – access will be maintained throughout. Residents of Raymond Buildings will be pleased to learn that the lock to the pedestrian gate leading into Jockey's Field will soon be replaced with a mechanism operating from a smaller key. Replacement keys will be made available when the work proceeds.

<u>Library</u>
