Scholarships Trust

Car Parking

<u>Car parking</u> spaces are available in various locations throughout the estate accessed from High Holborn, Gray's Inn Road and Theobald's Road. Annual Permits cost £2,760. Library

The Library has now launched its bespoke one-to-one training sessions which are available to book via the <u>Book a Librarian</u> form on the <u>Legal Research Training</u> section of the Library webpages.

These sessions are ideal if you have already started your research and need additional guidance in finding and using legal resources, or if you are new to a certain area of law and need a brief guide as to where to start.

The latest edition of the Library User Guide is also available <u>online</u> and in hardcopy from the Library.

Members can now sign up to receive the <u>Library Bulletin</u>, which will be published periodically throughout the year to keep Library users up to date with current opening hours, services and events. Previous bulletins can be accessed through the <u>Library Bulletin Archive</u>.

Attention is also drawn to the attractive and informative re-designed Library noticeboards both in the ground-floor lobby area and directly outside the entrance on the first floor. In particular the Gray's Inn Library History in Pictures display is well worth a look.

The New Books wall (opposite the photocopiers) boasts new titles on the Human Rights Act, advertising law, Lord Justice Jackson's account of his civil justice reforms and the latest edition of Bewigged and Bewildered, the guide to becoming a barrister in England and Wales.
