

Landmark climate change guidance for solicitors

Landmark climate change guidance has today (19 April) been launched by the Law Society of England and Wales.

The release of the Guidance on the Impact of Climate Change on Solicitors follows on from the Law Society committing to its Climate Change Resolution in 2021.*

"The effects of climate change - even on legal practices - are wide-ranging and constantly evolving," said Law Society President Lubna Shuja.

General Counsel are in a position to advise on the impacts of climate risks on the commercial function of their organisation, including impending policy, legal and regulatory changes which may present opportunities and/or risks for their organisations. In-house lawyers may need to consider and seek educational resources as needed for this role and also to consider if external legal advisors have the relevant skills for their retainer.
















Net Zero Action Principles
